How you will contribute

The IT Manager is responsible for efficiently planning, organizing, and managing information technology (IT) services and support across BFM Foundation Canada and Mission Thrift Stores nationwide. Reporting to the CFO, this role involves coordinating IT projects, managing resources, and executing other assignments as delegated. Key responsibilities include resolving software and hardware issues, prioritizing IT tasks and personnel, managing contracts, providing mobile device and POS support, and ensuring cybersecurity. Support will be delivered via telephone, electronic channels, or in-person as required.

Primary Activities (For Both BFM Foundation and Mission Thrift Stores)

- Participates in all hardware and software evaluations
- Manages all IT related vendor contracts
- Analyzes complex business needs presented by the user community and/or clients and recommends technical solutions
- Identify opportunities and recommend solutions that will enhance or improve current business processes.
- Assist with Budget planning for all IT related budget line items.
- Represents the IT function during companywide strategic planning
- Troubleshooting, education, and technical support for BFM Foundation and Mission Thrift Stores IT related issues.
- Email and licenses support.
- Onboarding/Offboarding as it relates to IT.

- Ensures software, hardware and network installations, re-installs, upgrades, moves, changes and relocations are made when necessary and as required.
- Assist on any projects or special initiatives as assigned
- Manage cloud-based systems and system migrations.
- Ensures the consistency and maintainability of existing applications by creating, maintaining, and enforcing standards/procedures for implementing technical solutions
- Follows up on faulty hardware and software purchases by pursuing warranty advantages through distributors and manufacturers
- Backing up of all necessary systems at a frequency necessary for day-to-day operations.
- Provide recommendations on security improvements, software licenses and technology purchases.
- Ensures secure data flow and implements necessary measures to mitigate any risk of a data breach
- Oversees security levels given to files and folders in data repository.
- Stay updated on cybersecurity breaches to mitigate risks.

Qualifications

- 3 5 years' relevant work experience.
- Post Secondary Degree or Diploma in computer science, or an acceptable combination of education and relevant experience required.
- Proficiency with VPN/Cloud Based networks, firewalls, encryption, and other aspects of network security technologies.
- Highly effective project management skills.
- Sound leadership, staff management, and teambuilding skills.
- Ability to explain technical concepts and theories to non-technical audiences

Working Conditions

The IT Manager will report to the Chief Finance Officer (CFO) of BFM and collaborate regularly with other BFM Staff. Some travel is required for staff meetings, regional events, and other functions. The ideal candidate will reside within commuting distance of the Newmarket Support Centre and be available to work onsite as required. The role involves a minimum of one day per week at the Newmarket office, with the possibility of working remotely up to four days per week. While remote work is an option, preference will be given to candidates located in the local area. This is a permanent, full-time position.

Remuneration

The salary for this position will be based on qualifications and experience. The range is between \$85,000.00 and \$95,000.00. In addition to this is very competitive health and dental coverage and an annual RRSP contribution.
